PRINCE2® provides an easily tailored and scaleable project management methodology for all types of projects. PRINCE2® describes procedures how to design, supervise and evaluate a project, how to coordinate people, resources and activities and what to do if the project has to be adjusted if it doesn't progress as planned.

The course will provide participants with a complete and practical understanding of the PRINCE2® management method.
